





EUREKA SCIENCE MUSEUM WORKSHOPS (50 min)



Our students will have the opportunity to visit the Eureka Science Museum and participate in several Workshop that will allow them to learn about Cellular World, Electricity, Anatomy, Universe and Planet Earth, Chemistry, Genetics or Physics of Movement, among other topics.





OUR ACTIVITIES & EXCURSIONS

Planet Hearth in the Universe.

After learning about the structure of the Solar System and the celestial bodies that make it up, we will build and learn how to use a planisphere, which will help us observe the sky.

The Colours of Chemistry.

When lights illuminates our surroundings the world fills with colors. But, what is their origin? And how are these colours produced? Through various chemical experiments we will answer these questions.

Look, look...It's a cell!

Once you know the rules to follow in the laboratory and have received some basic notions about the use of the microscope, we will take a close look at cells, preparing and observing different animal and plant samples.

Electricity.

In this spectacular workshop, we will experiment with the fundamentals of electricity, with the help of the plasma ball, the Van Der Graaf generator, Faraday's cage and Tesla's generator.









Action Reaction!

Acid and bases, redox reactions, catalysis. We will learn to prepare various chemical reactions and we will learn about the importance of the chemical ingredients that we will use in each one of them.

Practical genetics.

We will extract and visualize human DNA and carry out an electrophoretic analysis of samples in criminal and health cases taken from fiction.


Physics of Movement.

We will experiment with physics to learn the fundamental laws of Newtonian mechanics or circular motion: free fall, centre of masses, gyroscope...

Anatomy.

Through the dissection of a sheep's entrails, we will learn to recognize different organs, paying special attention to the heart and blood circulation. We will complete the workshop with a guided tour of the Plastination Hall.

Math Mystery Box.

Students, through mathematical knowledge and collaborative work, will have to overcome some challenges that will allow them to open a set of closed boxes with locks, keys, etc.

There's Chemistry here!

Why do atoms join with each other? And, how do they do it? What is the difference between an ionic bond and a covalent bond? Working in groups, and through experimentation, we will gain an understanding of the properties of different chemical structures.

Cellular world.

We will review how cells are classified and, using the microscope, we will prepare and observe different cell samples.

A panoramic tour of the beautiful city of San Sebastian. You do not want to miss it!






Spend the afternoon exploring the aquarium. There's plenty of time to see all the sea creatures and you can even find Nemo.

We will visit the City history museum after a short hiking, and then enjoy delicious churros with hot chocolate.
















Visit the science museum for a hands-on afternoon of experiments and exploration!

Could you imagine a better way to practice your Spanish together and have a great time?












SPORTS & BEACH

The stand up paddle course takes place in La Concha bay, and is held on Tuesday and Thursday. The course includes all the necessary equipment.












Visit this architecturally important city with a tour of the Guggenheim Museum then afterwards we'll head to the "Casco Viejo". We'll go for a stroll along the river.

We will visit the medieval town Hondarribia, the ancient old quarter with walls and the colorful port with fisher houses. We can even finish having a swim in the beach!










We will walk along Leitzaran green way and we will enjoy the waterholes and the river.
